The People's Choice Prize will be announced at the Closing Ceremony of Shinju Matsuri on Sunday 18 September. One work will be selected as the winner from the above categories.

ACQUISITIVE

The winning entry of the Shire of Broome Acquisitive Art Prize will become the property of the Shire of Broome and will be housed in the Shire's Shinju Art Collection.

SOLD WORKS

Works that are sold are available for collection Monday 19 September during Shire Office hours. The purchaser, prior to any work being sent, will pay postage and handling.

TECHNICAL ADVISORY PANEL

A Technical Advisory Panel will evaluate works against the Conditions of Entry. In the event that a work is not deemed to have followed the conditions of entry and is not suitable to be hung, or displayed, artists will be advised and will be able to pick up works on Monday 12 September between 9am and 4pm.

Conditions Of Entry

1. The Shinju Matsuri Art Awards are open to bona fide residents (6 months) of Broome and the Kimberley region.
2. All entries must be the original work of the artist and have been completed within the last 12 months and not entered in any previous art awards.
3. An agent may enter on behalf of an artist and receive any award provided that evidence of agency or authority from the artist can be sighted.
4. Each work can be entered into one category only, one entry per artist.
5. The entry fee is \$35 including GST per entry and is not refundable.
6. All work must be suitably presented for display with fittings attached ready for hanging or standing as applicable.
7. ALL 2D WORKS ARE RESTRICTED TO **MAXIMUM DIMENSIONS** 150cm x 150cm. ALL 3D WORKS ARE RESTRICTED TO **MAXIMUM DIMENSION** of 150cm in any one direction, and be able to be moved without mechanical assistance.
8. Each entry must be clearly marked with completed details attached to the back of the artwork.
9. Each entry must be declared through a completed Entry Form submitted prior to the ENTRIES CLOSE date (29/08/11).
10. All works must be for sale. If the winning entry of the Shire of Broome Acquisitive Art Prize is valued in excess of the prize amount, \$7,000, the artist shall accept the Prize amount only.
11. All care will be taken with entries but Shinju Matsuri Inc and the Shire of Broome are not responsible for damage or loss. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
12. The artist agrees that the organisers reserve the right to take photographs of exhibits for reproduction or publicity purposes. The winner retains copyright of the work but acknowledges the right of Shinju Matsuri Inc and Shire of Broome to reproduce the winning artworks in any medium for the sole purpose of promoting Shinju Matsuri or the Art Awards and Acquisitive Prize.
13. It is recommended you photograph your work prior to entering the competition in the event of it being sold.
14. Works may not be removed from the exhibition until the end of the advertised exhibition period.
15. All entries are to arrive free of freight costs and return the same way. Shinju Matsuri Inc is not responsible for any delivery or return freight charges.
16. A Technical Advisory Panel will determine whether an entry has satisfied the terms and conditions and is suitable for display. The Technical Advisory Panel's decision is final and artists will be notified prior to the exhibition opening if their pieces are not exhibited.
17. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
18. For ease of curating the awards, 2 photographs or scanned copies of the artwork should be attached to the Entry Form.
19. The final Retail Sale Price will be set by Shinju Matsuri Inc to include a 20% commission to Shinju Matsuri Inc, +GST.
20. Shinju Matsuri Inc endorses the right of the judge to withhold prizes.
21. The judges decision of the winning entries is final.
22. In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of conditions, the decision of Shinju Matsuri Inc is final.
