SHINJU MATSURI FLOAT PARADE 2011

The Board of Shinju Matsuri invites individuals, groups and businesses to enjoy the festivities that present a community working together in a true celebration of all the various cultures and people who call Broome their home.

The Float Parade is a fantastic way to express community spirit & culture in a colourful procession of floats, vehicles and performers. The Float Parade is a collection of the different community, business and interest groups in Broome and is open to everyone to watch and participate in.

It's not about how much you spend or how ostentatious your float, or who takes home a prize. It is about the harmonious celebration of multiculturalism and diversity that reinforces the colour and welcoming spirit of Broome.

There is no prescribed theme for the Float Parade although we ask that floats maintain the spirit of Shinju Matsuri celebrating multiculturalism, team work, volunteering and identity without denigrating or disrespecting others.

SAFETY FIRST

The safety of float participants and spectators is paramount.

Please read the Conditions of Entry and implement the appropriate safety precautions pertaining to your type of float / vehicle

Conditions Of Entry

- 1. Safety of float participants and spectators is paramount. Please implement the appropriate safety precautions pertaining to your type of float / vehicle.**
2. Speed limit will not exceed 8km/hour.
3. Float participants must strictly follow the official route and not detour whatsoever during the event.
4. Children on floats must be under the supervision of adults at all times.
5. We recommend that open floats on backs of vehicles have some sort of barrier around the perimeter of the vehicle's tray to prevent falling.
6. We recommend that participants on the back of open vehicles be seated.
7. Float participants must follow the instructions of Marshals or Traffic Wardens at all times.
8. Drivers of vehicles must not engage in other activities—such as engaging with the crowd, throwing lollies, taking photographs.
9. Drivers following pedestrian floats should allow a greater distance in the event of needing to brake suddenly.
10. ALL DISPLAYS ARE RESTRICTED TO THE **DIMENSIONS** OF THE FLOAT OR VEHICLE .
11. Height of float must not interfere with overhead power lines, street signage etc.
12. Items forming part of the display on vehicle floats must be securely tied down.
13. Each entry must be declared through a completed Entry Form submitted prior to the ENTRIES CLOSE date (19/08/11).
14. All care will be taken with entries but Shinju Matsuri Inc are not responsible for damage or loss. Insurance is the responsibility of the creators.
15. The entrant agrees that the organisers reserve the right to take photographs of floats for reproduction or publicity purposes. The winners retain copyright of the float but acknowledges the right of Shinju Matsuri Inc and to reproduce the winning floats in any medium for the sole purpose of promoting Shinju Matsuri or the float parade.
16. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
17. The entry fee is \$55 including GST and is non-refundable.
18. Shinju Matsuri Inc. reserves the right to reject an application for entry.
19. The name of the applicant must be true and accurate.
20. The entry fee is \$55 including GST and is not refundable.
21. For ease of scheduling the parade, 2 photographs or plans of the float should be attached to the Entry Form.
22. The winner of the Best Overall Float is ineligible to win any other category prize.
23. Shinju Matsuri Inc endorses the right of the judges to withhold prizes.
24. The judges decision on the winning entries is final.
25. In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of conditions, the decision of Shinju Matsuri Inc is final.
26. Float participants must adhere to the standards of common decency and in the spirit of a community / family event by not displaying material of an explicit, vulgar, offensive or inflammatory nature.
