## Float Parade

Each year, the people of Broome look forward to the fun and the mayhem of the Shinju Matsuri Float Parade. If you are in Broome, you are either part of it or you watch it!

It is an integral feature of the Shinju Matsuri calendar with Floats representing the diversity of the Broome community, making their way from Weld Street to Male Oval cheered on by thousands along the way.

This year it will take place on Sunday 26th August, starting from 3pm. Marshalling to take place from 2pm.

### **THEME:**

This year Floats should simply reflect 'the spirit of Shinju'.

### **KEY TIMINGS:**

**Date: SUNDAY 26 August 2018**

**SET UP/MARSHALLING: 2pm**

Line up outside the Broome Shire Offices on Weld Street next to your allocated Float Number. The numbers will be hand marked on the kerb, and an order for the Parade will be sent a couple of days before the Parade.

**VENUE/LOCATION:** Start line is on the corner of Barker St & Weld St

**PARADE START TIME: 3 pm**

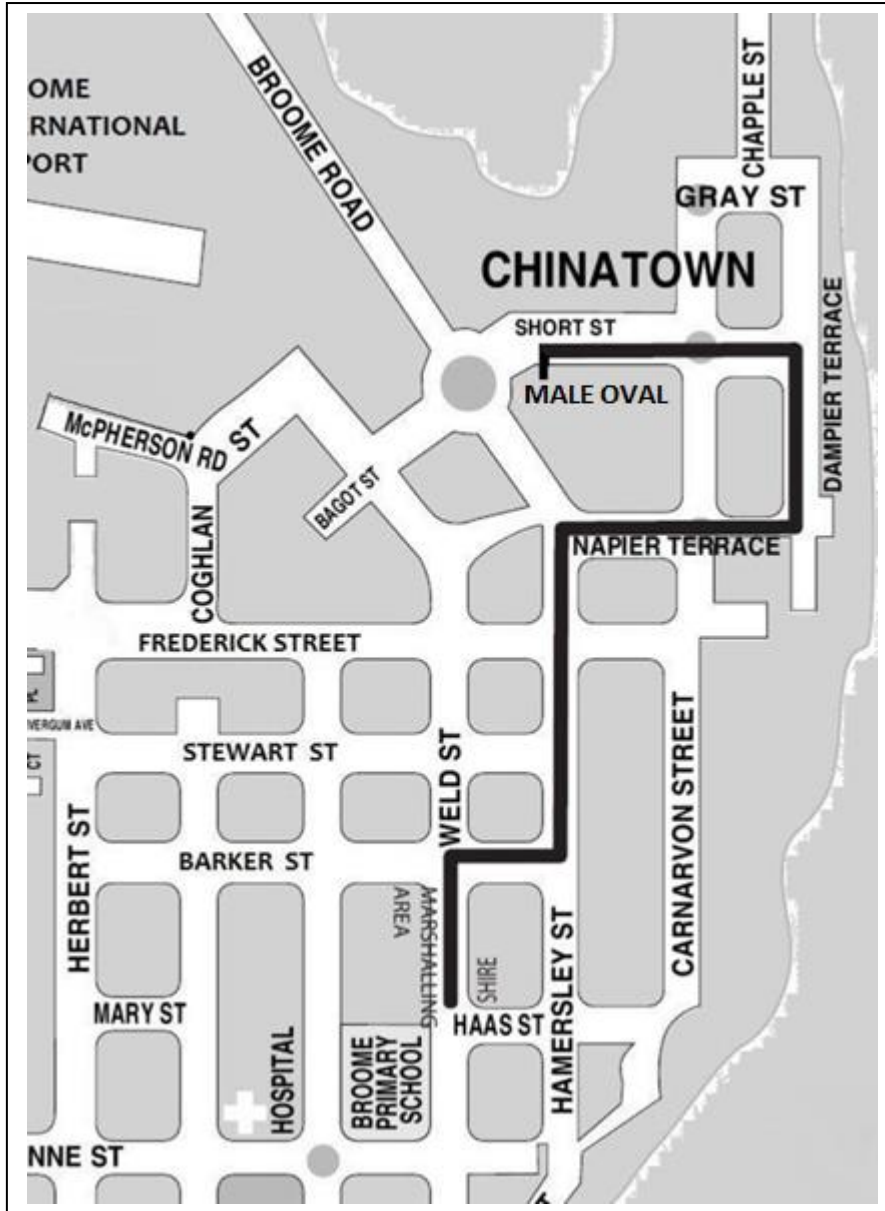

## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Safety of float participants and spectators is paramount. Please implement the appropriate safety precautions pertaining to your type of float/vehicle.
2. Speed limit MUST not exceed 8km/hour
3. Float participants must strictly follow the official route and not detour whatsoever during the event.
4. Children on floats must be under adult supervision at ALL times.
5. Open floats on backs of vehicles must have some sort of barrier around the perimeter of the vehicle's tray to prevent falling.
6. It is recommended that participants on the back of open vehicles be seated while vehicle is moving and at all times during the route of the parade.
7. Floats must follow the instructions of official Shinju Matsuri Marshals, Traffic Wardens and staff at ALL times.
8. Drivers of vehicles must not engage in any other activities such as taking photos, engaging with the crowd etc.
9. Drivers following pedestrian floats should allow a greater distance in the event of needing to brake suddenly.
10. ALL DISPLAYS ARE RESTRICTED TO THE DIMENSIONS OF THE FLOAT OR VEHICLE THAT ARE ON THE SUBMITTED ENTRY FORM PROVIDED TO SHINJU.
11. Height of the float must not interfere with overhead power lines and street signage.
12. Items forming part of the display on vehicle floats must be securely tied down.
13. Each float/entry must be declared through a completed official Shinju Matsuri entry form submitted prior to the entries close date.
14. Road Regulations of the WA State Department of Transport apply.
15. All care will be taken with float entries, but Shinju Matsuri Inc. is not responsible for damage or loss. Insurance is the responsibility of the creators.
16. The entrant agrees that the organisers reserve the right to take photographs of floats for reproduction or publicity purposes. The winners retain copyright of the float but acknowledges the right of Shinju Matsuri Inc. to reproduce the winning floats in any medium for the sole purpose of promoting Shinju Matsuri or the float parade.
17. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
18. The entry fee is \$66 including GST and is non-refundable.
19. By submitting the entry form either by document or online, the entrant agrees to abide by these terms and conditions.
20. Shinju Matsuri Inc. reserves the right to reject an application for entry.
21. The name of the applicant must be true and correct.
22. For ease of scheduling the parade, two photographs or plans of the float should be attached to the entry form.
23. The winner of the Best Overall Float is ineligible to win any other category prize.
24. Shinju Matsuri Inc. endorses the right of the judges to withhold prizes.
25. The judge's decision on the winning entries is final.



26. In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of conditions, the decision of Shinju Matsuri Inc. is final.
27. Float participants must adhere to the standards of common decency and in the spirit of a community/family event by not displaying material of an explicit, vulgar, offensive or inflammatory nature.
28. Shinju Matsuri Inc assumes no responsibility in connection with and makes no representation as to safety of any Parade Entry, in whole or in part.
29. The ultimate responsibility for safety lies with each individual Entry.
30. Code of Conduct Clause; All entrants are to behave in a respectful way towards other entrants, the public, staff, volunteers, staff and Shinju Matsuri Inc. (i.e. no defamatory comments publicly). A breach of the code of conduct will result in the entrant's work being disqualified. If breached after receiving prizes or winning, entrants will be required to reimburse Shinju Matsuri Inc any prize or prize money.

## **ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

The following information is important. We are working with the Police and other Authorities to provide a safe event. Please read these instructions and share with others in your Float.

- Children who are aged seven and under MUST be seated during the Float Parade and must be under the supervision of adults at ALL times.
- NOONE can travel in or on a trailer.
- Drivers of vehicles must not engage in any other activities such as taking photos, engaging with the crowd throwing lollies etc.
- Drivers following pedestrian floats should allow a greater distance in the event of needing to brake suddenly.
- Height of the float must not interfere with power lines, street signage etc.
- Items forming part of the display on vehicle floats must be securely tied down.
- Smoking will not be permitted on any float taking part in the Parade.
- All vehicles should be checked and in good mechanical condition and properly serviced prior to the Parade.

**ALL FLOATS MUST ADHERE TO TERMS & CONDITIONS AND STANDARDS OF COMMON DECENCY AS WELL AS THE SPIRIT OF THE EVENT.**
